SUMMER HAZARDS - BBQS



When we are having our BBQs during the summer months, lots of people know that hot coals can be a danger for pets. But the smoke from the BBQ can also irritate your pet's airway, especially if they can't move away.

Always make sure any small pets are far away from the BBQ and let dogs or cats inside the house if they seem to be getting a little too close to hot BBQs or smoke.

Don't be tempted to give your pet tasty treats from the BBQ. Many human foods are best avoided by pets and alcohol is a definite no-no.

Ask guests not to leave food, skewers or hot cooking tools within your pet's reach.

Important - Make sure waste bins are secure, corn on the cob husks and wrappers can be very tempting for your pet but can cause dangerous gut blockages.

SUMMER HAZARDS - STINGS, ALLERGIES & BLUE-GREEN ALGAE



Other dangers to watch out for in summer are insect bites or stings, blue-green algae in water and allergy flare ups. Please keep an eye out for warning signs and always ensure it is safe before allowing your dog to swim or drink from standing water.

WARNING

Blue-green Algae bloom(s) have been spotted in this waterbody!

Avoid Harmful Blue-green Algae Blooms while swimming, fishing and boating









Keep kids and pets away from areas with blooms or scum. Swim, fish and boat in areas with no blooms or scum.

Contact can make people and animals sick.

If contact occurs, rinse with clean water.

If symptoms occur, contact a medical provider.









Blooms can look like streaks, spilled paint, pea soup, floating clumps or dots.

~ 10% off vaccines and free nurse clinics ~




This year Rabbit Awareness Week takes place from the 30th June to the 7th July.

INSURANCE PROCESS





- Please remember to advise us what condition you are claiming for.
- Your insurance company may charge you an excess for each new condition.
 - **♦** We aim to complete your claim within 10-14 days of receipt.
- We do not routinely accept direct claims (where your insurance company pays us directly after a claim has been made). However, if there are exceptional circumstances please ask to speak to our practice manager.
- There is an administration charge for completing a claim and the cost depends on whether it is a new condition or an existing condition.
- This administration fee covers the cost of nursing staff time to process the claim, and the veterinary surgeon's time to check and sign-off the claim.
- When sending or handing in your claim, please make sure you have completed the following:
 - policy number
 - the condition you are wanting to claim for
 - that you have signed the form!

Pet Healthcare Plan

The aim of our Pet Healthcare plan is to provide your pet with the best possible preventative healthcare, whilst allowing you to spread the cost with affordable monthly payments throughout the year.

Vaccination is extremely important to protect your pet from infectious diseases and maintain good health. All plans therefore incorporate annual boosters including kennel cough for dogs and risk assessed feline leukaemia virus for cats. Parasite prevention, especially worming, is also vital in protecting the health of your pet and family. All treatments should be based on risk and so we have two options for dogs and cats with tick and worming treatments dependent on their lifestyle:
